- * Projection time is about 50 minutes, with an explanation of the starry sky and a short movie program.
* On weekdays (Tuesday through Saturday), the program may change to an educational one for group admission.
* Special period will be Spring/Summer/Winter vacation for elementary and junior high schools.

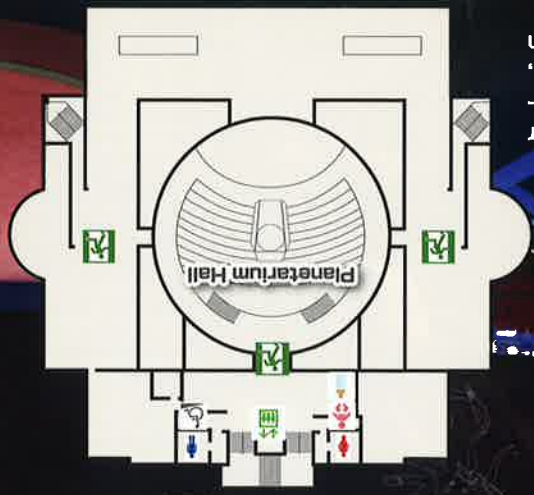

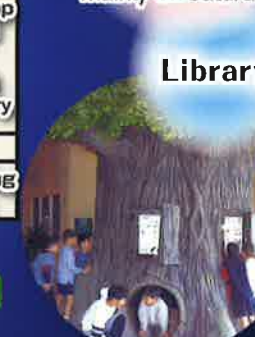
